

DRESSING & UNDRESSING OF FIELDS:

For several years it has been the practise of both teams kicking off on the first fixture of any ground in the NWSWS, to pick up (1) one bag of nets and three corner posts from the Morrison Bay Complex on Sunday morning and take them to the ground and dress one half of the field.

The same occurs on the last fixture of the ground and both teams undress the field and bring the equipment back to Morrison Bay Complex.

Due to the expansion in our Association and now the utilization of a number of grounds outside the Morrison Bay Complex, we believe new procedures and instructions are required to lessen the chance of confusion and delays in starting matches on time.

For the following grounds the instructions will be as follows:

- **Morrison 1, 2, 3, 5 & 8**
- **Bremner**
- **Bill Mitchell**
- **Monash**
- **Meadowbank 4**

It will now be the responsibility of the Home team or the team named first on the draw to pick up both sets of nets and six corner posts on Sunday morning and take them to the nominated field.

It will then be the responsibility of both teams to dress one half of the field each upon arrival of the fore mentioned equipment.

At the cessation of the days play, it will be the responsibility of both teams to playing the last fixture to undress one half of the field and the Home team to return all the equipment back to the Morrison Bay complex storage facility and be checked in by an Association delegate prior to storage. (Please ensure all pegs are returned in the net bag).

For the following grounds the instructions will be as follows:

- **Meadowbank 8 & 9**
- **LH Waud**

With the re-emergence of West Ryde Rovers to our Association and with the kindness of Anne Montgomery and Karen Waud, we have been able to achieve an agreement, where Anne Montgomery will issue nets and posts from the New Administration Block next to the Netball Courts & LH Waud for the above mentioned fields, after 8am on a Sunday Morning.

Again it will be the responsibility of the Home team or first named team in the draw to obtain the equipment from Anne or West Ryde Rover delegate and take it to the appropriate field for both teams to dress one half of the field.

Upon cessation of play it will be the responsibility of both teams to undress the field and for the Home team to return the equipment to Anne or WRR delegate.

Please **do not waste time in undressing the fields** as Anne has other duties to carry out on a Sunday afternoon.

NOTE: Do not return equipment to Morrison Bay complex from Meadowbank complex, with the exception of Meadowbank No4

For the following ground the instructions will be as follows:

- **Macquarie University**

All equipment for the Macquarie Uni ground is provide by Macquarie Uni and as such there is no need to attend Morrison Bay Complex first match of the day.

At the cessation of the last fixture of the day, both teams are to undress the field and store the equipment as directed by Gloria Chan or a Macquarie Uni delegate.

We trust that this procedural instruction clarifies the requirements of all fields being used by our Association and we will not have the confusion and aggravation that has unfortunately occurred over the last couple of weeks.
